### **NOTICE ABOUT REDGRAVE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT**

The Redgrave Parish Council received the results of a mandatory annual safety inspection on its playground equipment on Friday 22 Jan 22. Unfortunately, this required the immediate closure of three items of play equipment: 2 sets of swings and the zip wire. As a result, we have disabled these particular items to make sure that we do not endanger anyone's safety. Other items of play equipment needed varying degrees of work but did not require closure at this time.

Llanover Estate, the landowner, had already terminated the lease on the Recreation Ground and instructed the Redgrave Amenities Trust to clear the land of its equipment by 25 Jun 22. We have been waiting for quotes from contractors before removing the play equipment. This situation has meant that it makes no sense to expend money to comply with the safety inspection recommendations. So, we have had to proceed more quickly to vacate the land and without contractor support. As a result, the Parish Council and Redgrave Amenities Trust will work together over the next week or so to remove all of the play equipment from the old Recreation Ground.

The Parish Council is looking to provide a new Children's Playing Field and equipment as soon as possible but this is likely to take several months.
