

REDGRAVE CHARITY FOR THE NEEDY AND MARY FOSTER CHARITY

Redgrave Charity for the Needy owns the Redgrave Fen which it leases to the Suffolk Wildlife Trust, and the Widows Pightle half way down Bier Lane which it leases to the farmer who owns all of the land around it.

The Mary Foster charity owns Steeple Meadow below St Marys Church which it leases to Redgrave Church Heritage Trust.

The Needy Charity makes small grants to people in Redgrave or nearby who are in hardship. The Mary Foster charity gives small grants for children who go to Botesdale primary school and would be disadvantaged versus their peers for clothing and school trips.
