1. Apologies from Mr K Green Mr A Aves and County & District Councillors Mr C Michell and Mrs S Michell
2. The chairman welcomed everyone
3. There were no declarations of interest
4. The minutes of meeting of Wednesday 12 September 2005 were agreed as a true record
5. There were no matters arising not covered by this agenda
6. *Open discussion with county and district councillors, and services*  
*Apologies were received from our district and county councillors so there was no discussion. It was noted that there had been no police representative for many months. It was agreed to add the community liaison officer to the email list*
7. *Open discussion with residents*  
*Mr Mitchell proposed a vote of thanks to the team which had constructed the extension to the Activities Centre.*  
*There had been another accident at the Redgrave Park end of the Street. Apparently a motorcyclist had been in collision with a deer. There was a discussion on how to keep speeds down in the village. It was suggested to see whether we can borrow a speed camera. Ian Baird to check if police can loan one. Bob Hayward to check if there is a cheap device for measuring speed.*

E-on Energy direct debit £14.63 had been notified  
The request for donation by West Suffolk Victim Support was not agreed  
Agreed to pay Botesdale Parish Council £190 towards War Memorial cleaning, repair & Fusilier B Cox plaque.  
The budget and precept were set for 2006/7. The precept was agreed level at £7500 thus maintaining the record of no increase for the past 3 years  
The band D local tax for £7500 precept is £30.71 per year or 59 pence per week  
An insurance sub-committee will be set up to re-assess the level of insurance cover.  
There is also an action to discuss with the Parochial Church Council on how best to maintain the churchyard.
10. Young people meeting  
The preliminary findings were that probably there is no need for more activities but there is a need for more volunteers to better run existing activities. There is a need to provide more facilities on our existing play areas.
