8. *Open discussion with county and district councillors, and services*  
*There were 3 minor recorded crimes in Redgrave this quarter. The theft of a cycle was solved. Next year neighbourhood policing will be done by a team comprising reactive officers and neighbourhood officers*  
*There is a drive towards using Endeavour House as a community resource for events. There was considerable discussion on the bus cuts. So far peak services for work in Diss are planned to restart after August Bank Holiday. The draft letter of reply to SCC had been circulated to parish council members for comment. It was suggested that a sentence was added pointing out the lack of logic in referring to severe budget pressures when supposedly changes had already been made to remove those pressures. Then send. It was unanimously agreed to continue to go in as hard as necessary to get the bus services restored. R Hayward had kept everyone fully informed at all stages in the actions which were agreed by us all.*
