#### **Redgrave Annual Parish Meeting (APM)**

The APM will take place at All Saints Church, Redgrave, at 6pm on Tuesday 5th May. Speaker details:

**Nikita Goodrich from the Local Planning Authority will talk about the Mid Suffolk District Council Call For Sites Process and other Housing Planning Issues**

***There are currently 8 Call For Sites identified in Redgrave.*** The Call for Sites process is a standard part of a local authority's preparation for a Local Plan. It is an invitation to landowners, developers and community groups to suggest pieces of land that could, in theory, be suitable for future development. This helps Councils understand what land is potentially available to meet housing targets before they start to form proposals in their Local Plan as to where such development should be.

The 8 Call for Sites identified in Redgrave are currently going through this process. This does not mean that development will take place. Each site will go through detailed assessment and there will be further publicity and consultation before any decisions are made. Nikita will *not* be talking about the Redgrave sites specifically, but she will talk through the process in general and other housing planning issues.

We hope you will join us to gain an understanding of this process and how it impacts villages such as ours.

The APM will be followed by the normal annual Parish Council meeting - the agenda for which will be published shortly.
