We are thrilled to announce that Thrive at the Fen (based at Redgrave & Lopham Fen) in conjunction with its partner organisation The Pantry in Kenninghall has been shortlisted as a finalist in the Norfolk Rural Business Awards. Businesses from food and drink producers to tourism attractions, along with community organisations have been shortlisted for the awards which were launched last year by Norfolk County Council in partnership with the Royal Norfolk Agricultural Association (RNAA). The winners will be named at a ceremony at the Royal Norfolk show in June. Cllr Fabian Eagle, Cabinet Member for Economic Growth at Norfolk County Council, said: "Small independent businesses and community organisations bring diversity to our villages and towns and help attract visitors, and these awards recognise the important role they play."
