This was a significant piece of work carried out by a group of volunteer residents and which was adopted on 20th July 2022. REMINDER - National Emergency Alert test to Mobile Phones - 7th September

Just a reminder that the Government will be sending an emergency alert test to all mobile phones across the UK at around **3pm on Sunday 7th September**. During the test mobile phones will vibrate and make a loud siren sound for approximately ten seconds, even if the phone is set to silent.
