### **Redgrave Parish Council Communication with Residents**

The Parish Council has recently updated its Communications Policy and would just like to remind residents of the various ways you can keep up to date with what is going on in the village. First and foremost all information, including agenda and minutes of meetings and a hard copy of this bulletin, is printed and displayed on the Parish Council noticeboard which is next to the village pond. In addition, information is posted on the village website here [Parish Council » Redgrave Village](#) and some posted on the Parish Council and the village Facebook pages. All Parish Council meetings are open to the public and include a public participation period at the start. Meetings are held at All Saints Church starting at 7pm and residents are encouraged to come along. **Dates of meetings for 2026 are: 8 Jan, 5 Feb, 5 Mar, 2 Apr, 7 May, 4 Jun, 2 Jul, 6 Aug, 3 Sep, 1 Oct, 5 Nov and 3 Dec.** The agenda for each meeting is published in advance on the noticeboard, website and both the above mentioned Facebook pages. Once it is approved at the next meeting, the updated Communications Policy will be posted on the website.

### **Potential Purchase of Redgrave Woodland**

Thank you to those residents who have taken the time to complete a consultation form expressing your views on this possible purchase, which was featured in the last bulletin. The deadline for submitting the forms was 3rd January. This has been listed as an agenda item for discussion by Councillors at the next Parish Council meeting on 8th January. All residents are welcome to come along to add any further comments at the public participation period at the start of the meeting. Any decisions and next steps on the potential purchase will be published via our normal channels as listed above.

### **Redgrave Neighbourhood Plan Review**

Following the item in the November bulletin, a review of the Redgrave Neighbourhood Plan is now underway. The first stage is scoping, where the Parish Council will review each chapter of the Plan to identify what still works, what may need updating and any changes needed to reflect new national or local planning policy and evidence. Once this initial review is complete, residents, businesses and community groups across Redgrave will be invited to share their views so the Parish Council can hear and collect feedback from all interested parties. This is an early listening stage, with no decisions being made and no new policies or development sites proposed. Updates will continue to be provided in this bulletin as the review progresses and we also hope to relaunch the Redgrave Neighbourhood Plan website shortly.
